About the Witnesses: October is Domestic Violence Awareness month. As part of A Safe Place's outreach events during this month, wooden silhouettes have been placed in various locations around the island where they will be on display for 10 days (October 10th to October 20th). The silhouettes represent the women, men, and children who were domestic violence homicide victims in Massachusetts since August 2013.
